Chanute Recreation Commission Code of Conduct

Coaches, parents, program participants and spectators have a responsibility to conduct themselves in a respectful manner that represents good sportsmanship in all programs and activities.

Failure to abide by the Code of Conduct will result in ejection from the program/activity and possible suspension from future programs/activities.

- o Coaches, parents, program participants and spectators will refrain from the use of vulgar or unsportsmanlike conduct, mannerisms and language while at any CRC sponsored program/activity, including practices and games.
- o Coaches, parents, program participants and spectators will abide by the official's decision. The official's decision/call is not arguable. If you have a concern regarding the officiating contact the CRC.
- Verbal abuse, physical abuse, harassment and unsportsmanlike behavior towards an official, coach, parent, program participant, spectator or CRC staff are prohibited.
- o Involvement in a physical or verbal altercation with an official, coach, parent, program participant, spectator or CRC staff will result in ejection from the program/activity and possible suspension from future programs/activities.
- Any coach, parent, program participant or spectator that is ejected from the program/activity must leave the area immediately upon request. Failure to leave will result in suspension of the program/activity or forfeiture of the game.
